




An international meeting point

With ESS and the MAX IV Laboratory, Sweden acquires two research facilities that will be world leaders for decades to come. The construction of these facilities is accompanied by unique prerequisites for creating a meeting place of international excellence for dialogue and the exchange of thoughts, knowledge and ideas between the research community and the society around it. This rendezvous, which we call XS, rests on the following attributes:

- > a location right between two outstanding research centers with enormous potential to attract attention and to influence the way people live their lives.
- > the emergence of a new city quarter Lund NE with high aspirations and the possibility to get everything right from the outset.
- > a global development in which scientific communication has become increasingly important and changed character from "information" to "dialogue" and "public engagement".
- > a growing interest in "knowledge tourism" and 3.7 million people within an hour's journey.
- > the multidisciplinary research, the innovation activity and the international networks so richly represented in the immediate vicinity.
- > the historical context of the location: it has functioned as an international center for trade, the quest for knowledge and industrial development for two thousand years.

Success depends on thinking big — and enticing many helpful forces to collaborate. XS will be characterized by new thinking, by people's curiosity and by constructive dialogue. To achieve this, we want to make XS an enticing rendezvous that attracts flows of people from many different sources — and for many different reasons. In our model, XS consists of five parts with clear-cut roles and superb interaction.


